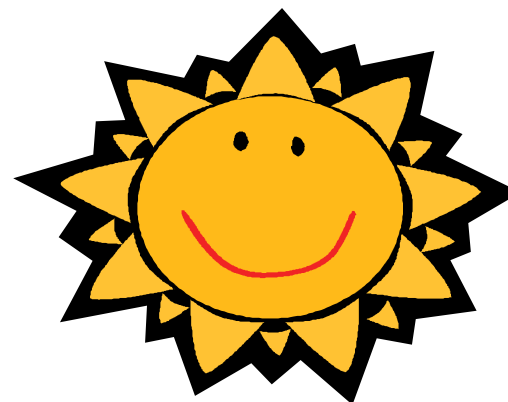

# CAMP CARDEN 2009

## Carden School of Sacramento

offers a variety of camp opportunities and provides a safe and fun learning environment for children. Our staff is dedicated to ensuring that students are engaged throughout the summer. We hope to make this summer a memorable time for your campers.

### Attendance

#### June 8 – August 21

Camp Carden attendance is accepted on a weekly basis and must be paid in advance. Students will not be permitted to attend field trips unless they are enrolled in the weekly camp.

### Registration Forms and Fees

There is a one-time registration fee of \$25.00 per student which includes a Camp Carden t-shirt to be worn on field trips. The weekly fee for Camp Carden is **\$165.00**. There will be additional fees for the swimming pool of \$10.00 a week and field trips (to be announced). Summer camp fees are due Friday, for the coming week of camp. This will allow us to staff accordingly for each week of camp. Please check the appropriate weeks you plan to have your children attend Camp Carden. Please be sure to complete **REGISTRATION** with **EMERGENCY INFORMATION** and **SWIM RELEASE** forms. These forms and fees will be accepted in the school office only. **NO Refunds** will be given after the camp week begins.

### Camp Hours / Extended Care

Our summer camp program offers children entering 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grades, hands-on activities, including; reading and math programs, recreational sports, media/computers, science, engineering and building projects, animals, arts/crafts, cooking, swimming and other outdoor activities and games.

**Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.**

Child care is provided before camp from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and after camp hours from 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. After 6:00 p.m. there will be a \$20.00 "late pick up fee" charged for each 15 minutes your children are on campus.

### Dress Code and Regulations

Dress is casual. Modest shorts and appropriate summer attire are acceptable. Campers may NOT wear spaghetti strap, halter tops, or tube type tank tops. Campers may NOT wear very short shorts or open toe shoes, as we will be extremely active. Camp Carden is not equipped to handle severe discipline problems. The school reserves the right to dismiss any student whose conduct, influence, attendance or progress is unsatisfactory.

### Swimming

1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade campers will enjoy swimming off-site, on Wednesday from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. each week. After lunch we will take a bus to the Arden Manor Pool. This facility has professional life-guards on duty AND Carden staff will supervise our campers, as well.

### Field Trips

Field trips will be announced weekly. The 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will **NOT** be permitted to remain on campus on field trip days, including swimming days. Should your child choose NOT to attend field trips, including swimming days, he/she will need to be picked up from the campus before the students depart for the field trip. NO exceptions.

### Treat Card

The card is available to those who choose to purchase treats each week. A treat card has 10 punches (or treats) for \$10.00. Each week our staff prepares sno-cones or popcorn as part of the afternoon activity. Cards can be purchased in the school office.
